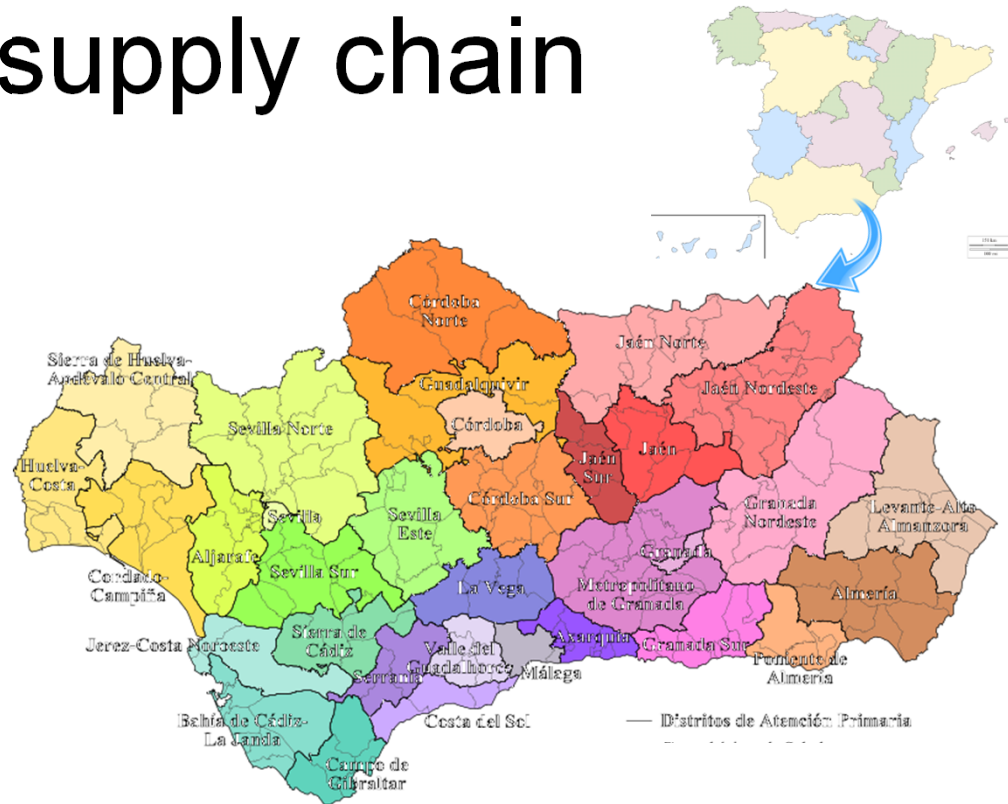

- Contact point in A.C. Andalucía Spanish Food Rapid Alert System
- Management of A.C. Andalucía alert system network (upward and downward notification)
- Part of SIASP (Integrated Public Health Alert System in Andalucía)
- Coordination with epidemiology surveillance service in outbreak investigations



Experience with tracing the food and feed supply chain

- As part of Spanish Food Rapid Alert System
 - Use of IT tools (ALCON)
 - Access to I-rassf portal
 - Management of traceability data from notifications
- AS part of SIASP
 - Management of alerts out of “office hours“
- Coordination with epidemiology surveillance service in outbreak investigations
 - Advice in food establishment investigation
